Want to foster a love of learning at home?
Tip #13: Incorporate Nature into Learning Experiences

TIP #14 Learn like Mowgli

In *The Jungle Book*, Mowgli learned that there is much to be learned from the animals, plants, & all that is in nature.

If you want to unlock the secrets of the trees, the way squirrels communicate, & the meaning of dancing bees, then you need to get outside & explore!

Nature is a welcoming teacher with an ever-changing classroom environment. Many lessons about life can be learned from interacting with nature. Just like Baloo reminded us, when you are outdoors interacting with the natural world, "the bare necessities of life will come to you."

Research shows that sensory exploration & immersion in natural realms can reinforce neural pathways & promote creative thinking. Use your eyes to observe the different things that birds eat – try to identify which ones are also eaten by people. Use your ears to listen to the sounds of the squirrels – discuss that it is not only the sounds that we make or the words that we say that carry meaning, but the way that we say them that has meaning. Feel the grass with your hands – use words to describe how it feels. Smell the air after the rain – discuss how it makes you feel & how it smells. Monitor how ants flock to a piece of food on the ground. Notice how they work together to take food back to the colony – discuss how people work can work together to accomplish bigger tasks. Carefully identify a few edible items from your garden or backyard – dandelions for example. While supervising your child, wash them, taste them, & describe how they taste.

Elements of nature elicit inherent curiosity in children. They can promote a sense of well-being & connectedness beyond the individual person & can fuel imaginative thinking!
