### TIP #17 Blend Subjects Together for Interdisciplinary Exploration

Use interests & strengths to explore new or seemingly less interesting concepts: When learning opportunities are provided which involve a combination of subject areas, children who may not feel confident or interested in one area may find ways to become curious & interested in that subject through the connection. For example, a child who enjoys making crafts may be uninterested in math. You could use the love of crafting to explore math. Have your child draw a jack-o-lantern that s/he wants to create before you being carving. Then work together to talk about the design using shape names; use a ruler to measure distances between the eyes & the size of the cuts to create symmetry. You can even explore the idea of ratios with a smaller drawing translating into a larger jack-o-lantern!

Engage in real world processes: In formal education, it is common practice to split learning opportunities into specific subject areas; however, in real-life, subject areas, concepts, and critical thinking are not typically so compartmentalized. Consider brainstorming the different skills & concepts involved in the creation of a cooperative project. For example, watch a Halloween movie together. Discuss how different skillsets are used to make the movie or animation such as the artist who draws the figures or the costume designer who uses history & creativity or the writer who has to come up with engaging dialogue to create perspective & connection to the characters.

Create opportunities to link experiences & activities to other subject areas: You can help your child to develop critical thinking skills, problem-solving strategies & flexibility in thought by introducing new perspectives or ways of interacting with objects & situations. For example, the game, Jenga can be a fun game that helps kids to develop visual discernment, hand-eye coordination, etc. Consider getting a Vis-à-vis marker & writing Halloween or seasonal vocabulary words on the side of each Jenga block. In order to remove the block, the player must use the vocabulary word in a meaningful sentence. The Vis-à-vis marker can be cleaned with water & different words can be use another time! You can even order the supplies you need right on the LMFWMC website!
