TIP #11 Promote Wonder through Exploration

Wonder is a sense of being fascinated, curious, engaged & challenged all at once. Children exercise wonder through play-based learning & exploration. Through play-based learning, children can pursue interests, learn from mistakes, and practice self-regulation.





With the onset of spring and seasonal changes, children can benefit from opportunities of play-based learning that explore nature and the outdoors. This is a great time to introduce children to appropriate equipment that can help them interact with nature and explore their surroundings. Magnifying glasses, prisms, binoculars, microscopes, insect nets, clay, and even microscopes can be fascinating tools for exploring the world and can offer great opportunities for bonding between parents and children.

Parents should model appropriate use of the tools and should never leave children unattended when there are small parts that can be choking hazards, materials which could suffocate, or if there is any risk for injury. Children should be encouraged to explore the different ways the tools work and be reminded that even though they may seem fun, they are "tools, not toys." They should be encouraged to discuss how they think the tool might work and find ways to compare & contrast the use of different tools.
