Harriet died a hero.








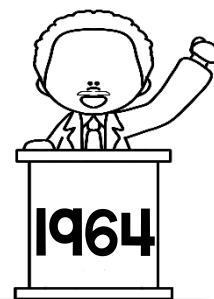

Ruby Bridges Timeline

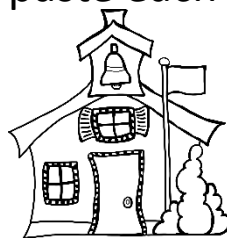

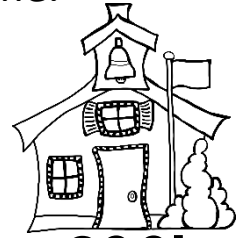
