








Let's start by learning the story of the Wizard of Oz.




# THE POWER OF MUSICAL STORYTELLING

Miss Gulch is the real-life counterpart to the Wicked Witch of East.

This theme is introduced when the mean neighbor, Miss Gulch, arrives and announces that she will have Dorothy's dog Toto destroyed.

The theme music pops up again during the tornado, and we watch as she transforms into the Wicked Witch of the East.

> Receives one beat Count "one" or "ta"


