## Mitzvah Scale

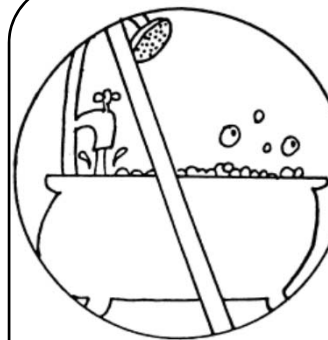
Measuring good deeds (mitzvot) and bad sins (aveiros).

on Yom Kippur**

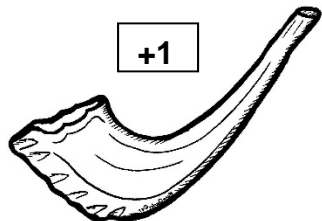


### (steps to) **Teshuva**

### **LUCKY SHOFAR CARD**

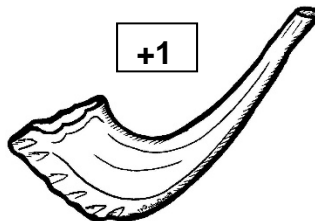
+1

card pile. **LUCKY !**

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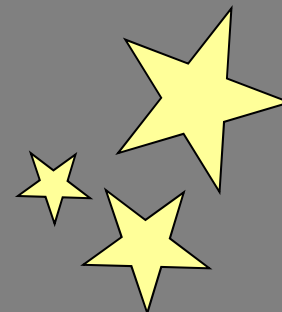
Teshuva is

"righteous".



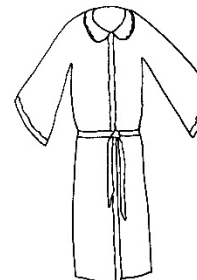
### **Yonah**

sin.

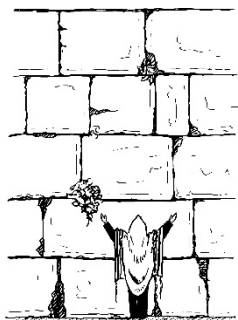


### **Tefillos**

The last service on  
Yom Kippur. It  
means *closing* or  
*locking*—locking  
the Holy Temple  
gates or gates of  
prayer.

Atonement

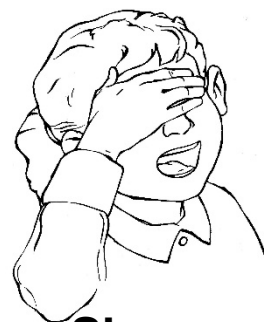
**10<sup>th</sup> of

Kippur.



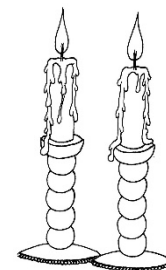
## Kaparot

Transfer our sins to  
a chicken and swing  
it around the head.



## Shema

"Baruch Shem K..."  
is usually  
whispered, but we  
say it out loud on  
Yom Kippur. Moshe  
heard the angels  
say it to Hashem.



## Lighting Candles

Light candles after  
dinner, before Yom  
Kippur starts, and  
say 2 blessings.
