Explore Environments

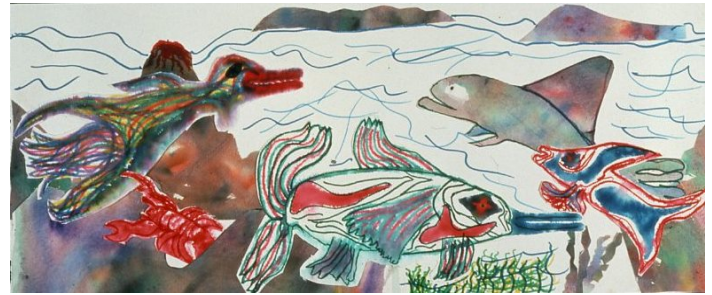
